

Dear Parents,

May 16, 2011

We are so excited about our trip to Splashville on May 25th. You will find the Splashville rules attached to this letter. The SISD code of conduct will apply, just as it does on school field trips. The dress code for this event is as follows: girls must wear a modest one-piece bathing suit, a two-piece "tankini" that covers the stomach or a regular two-piece with a dark shirt to wear the entire time. If they do not have a swimsuit then a dark colored t-shirt and shorts (not denim) can be worn. Boys must wear finger tip length swimming shorts or trunks and can wear a t-shirt if desired; Speedo-type swimwear is prohibited. All students need to bring a towel, sunscreen and an extra set of dry clothes if they wish to change when back on campus. If your student rides a bus they must have clothes to wear home after school. We will not be responsible for applying sunscreen to students (due to allergies), please remind your student to reapply sunscreen if you provide them with some. Students should come to school wearing their swimsuit under their clothes and appropriate shoes. We ask that you please write your child's name on his or her towel and any other belongings. Students will be solely responsible for all the belongings they take to Splashville. Splashville and SISD are not responsible for any lost or stolen items. Electronic equipment and water do not mix, so we ask students to leave those items at home. Splashville will be providing all the lifeguards and other safety personnel just like a normal operating day. Our school nurse will also be in attendance to help with any medical needs. Splashville will be near capacity with the entire school and all school staff members, therefore siblings of students will not be allowed to attend. Parents are welcome to come visit your student so that you can take pictures, apply sunscreen or check them out for the day. Students will not be allowed to be checked out for lunch and then returned. Your child's admission has been paid for and lunch and drinks will be provided. Students will be at Splashville from 10:00am to 2:00 pm. If you would like to pick your child up from Splashville, you must sign them out with the nurse who will notify their homeroom teacher. This is a celebration of all the hard work your student has demonstrated this school year and we are excited about this opportunity. Below you will see the permission form, if for some reason you do not want your child to attend please indicate that on this form and return to the student's homeroom teacher **no later than May 20, 2010.**
